



## HHS Strategy Framework

The Health and Human Services (HHS) Committee of Crown Family Philanthropies prioritizes the following areas of funding:

### Health

- Access to Quality Healthcare
- Prevention
- Supportive Services

### Human Services

- Economic Resiliency
- Safe Communities
- Stable Housing

CFP’s HHS Committee is committed to sustained impact on populations in need throughout Chicagoland and beyond. As such, the Committee favors organizations that move clients, patients, or participants along a *Continuum of care* (see below). The great majority of annual HHS funding will be allocated to organizations that make a case for transitioning clients toward increased stability, either within a given sector (e.g., shifting residents from emergency medical care to a medical home) or across sectors (e.g., supportive housing residents receiving job training/placement and supports to help sustain those jobs).

A reserve portion of the annual HHS budget will be set aside for organizations providing impactful services and resources that may not shift individuals across a continuum, but instead provide for basic needs and/or emergency services, or provide no direct services but advance advocacy and/or policy efforts around continuum of care.
